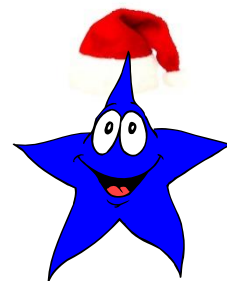

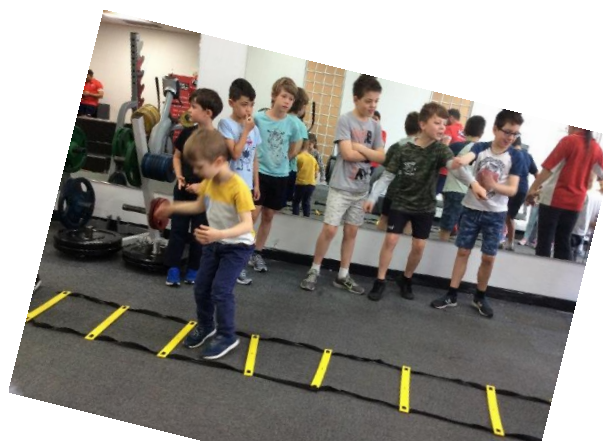

Important

- Discounts for more than 1 child in each family apply. The first child attending will be charged \$45 /day. Each sibling thereafter who attends on the same day will be charged \$40/day. This will not apply to late bookings!
- Excursion costs will be charged for each child attending. Childcare Benefit (CCB) and the Child Care Rebate (CCR) are available and will include both the daily fee and the excursion cost.
- Direct Debit forms can be obtained from the office. Children will not be able to attend vacation care until direct debit forms have been provided.
- **All payments will be deducted from accounts on Friday.**
- Fruit is provided daily.
- Please provide extra food as the children burn off heaps of energy on vacation care days and get really hungry.
- Children are to bring their own lunch and extra drinks on all days even when it is specified as provided on the program.

CHILDREN MUST BRING A WATER BOTTLE DAILY

- Cancellations require 2 weeks' notice in writing for complete refund of fees.
- Numbers may be limited for some excursions, so make sure you get in quick.
